Conditions for Schengen visa

The Netherlands participates in common arrangements for entry and visa with other European countries, These are the so called Schengen visa. Other participating countries are Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Iceland, Italy, Luxemburg, Norway, Portugal, Spain, and Sweden.

Documents to submit for a tourist or business visit to the Netherlands

Applicants appear in person must at least submit the following documents:

- one application form and one photo,
- a current passport valid for at least three months longer than the intended stay,
- a flight ticket,
- medical insurance valid for Europe.
- Additional documents or proof may be necessary in individual cases (e.g. hotel reservation/accomodation, invitation, business appointments).
